



Supplies:

- 1) Recycled plastic bottle
- 2) Pin/thumb tack
- 3) Scissors
- 4) 2 chopsticks or pencils
- 5) String or twine

Directions:

- 1) Wash and dry your plastic bottle
- 2) Use the thumb tack to poke two holes across from each other around 1-2" from the bottom of the bottle
- 3) At a 90 degree angle and 1-2" above the previous holes, poke two more opposite holes
- 4) Use scissors to cut .5" hole about 1-2" above each of the four holes.
- 5) Use scissors to widen each of the bottom four holes to be big enough for the pencils to slide through
- 6) Push pencils or chopsticks through the sets of opposite holes
- 7) Poke two holes on opposite sides of the top of the bottle
- 8) Push twine or string through the top two holes
- 9) Fill bottle with birdseed
- 10) Tie string around tree branch to hang outside
